COMMUNICATION

Open communication is just as important to us as the delivery of high-quality camp experiences. For that reason, we strive to communicate with families before and after every session. If you have questions or concerns, please feel free to contact your camp staff team.

CHILD PROTECTION

All visitors to the Sault Ste. Marie YMCA must scan their membership or companion cards or present government-issued photo identification in order to enter the facility. Camp Councilors will require that parents and guardians provide government-issued photo identification for signing campers in and out of camps.

STAFF

At the YMCA we pride ourselves in hiring the most qualified camp staff. All staff hold current Standard First Aid and CPR-C certification, and complete a training program prior to camp that includes Healthy Child Development, safety and emergency procedures. Staff 18 years and over have completed a Criminal Reference Check. All lifeguards hold National Lifeguard certifications.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

At YMCA Day Camps, the health and safety of your child is our first priority. The Sault Ste. Marie YMCA is a well-equipped health and wellness centre and has support staff who are trained to handle emergencies. The YMCA does not guarantee a nut-free facility. If your camper has a nut allergy, please include this information on the registration and medical forms. All camps are subject to change to be in accordance with Algoma Public Health guidelines.



HOW TO REGISTER

*** NO ONLINE REGISTRATION ***

Early Bird Registration begins April 3 - 15

General Registration begins April 17 - Aug 25

Campers must be registered for camp by 6:00pm the Friday before the start of camp.

Step 1: Register in person at the Membership Services desk by filling out a registration form and medical/behavioural forms (if necessary).

Please provide any and all '**authorized pick-ups**' for your child/children. All pick-ups require a Photo ID and children will only be released to those on the Authorized Pick-up list.

ALL CONTACT INFORMATION MUST BE FILLED OUT

(Phone numbers, email, emergency contacts, authorized pick-ups).

Step 2: Get ready for camp! Follow the What to Bring to Camp's preparation list and read over the Standards of Behaviour.

FAMILY RATE

Families receive a 10% discount for each additional sibling camper registered in the same camp.

CAMPER LUNCH

Lunches are not provided. Children play hard throughout the day and need constant nourishment and fuel. Please make sure that your child has a nutritious lunch and enough snacks to help them play all through the day. Reusable water bottles **MUST** be labelled.

MEMBERS

To get the membership pricing, you **MUST** be Y member from sign up until the end of summer.

SUPPORT

If your child has 1:1 support throughout the school year, your child will require a 1:1 support worker for the entire duration of registered camps. Please contact the Child, Youth and Family Supervisor for more information.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Email or in-person requests for cancellations, refunds or to change camp sessions must include the camper's full name and session dates.

Session changes will be made to the best of our ability and are dependent on availability. All changes must be made a minimum of two days prior to the start date of camp (the Monday of camp). A fee of \$20 will be applied for each change.

Cancellations/refunds must be reviewed and approved by Makayla Porcheron, Sydney Compeau and/or Michael Goodship.

Cancellation refunds are as follows:

- More than one week prior to the first day of camp is a full refund minus the \$20 administration fee
- less than one week (Monday to Monday) no refund.
- Medical emergency prior to the camp start date or mid-camp that prevents the camper from attending will result in a full credit applied to the child's account off a doctor's note is presented. A 20\$ administration fee will be applied in this case.
- Campers absent on the day of camp without the above-mentioned notice will result in no refund or credit.
- Campers leaving camp mid-session due to behavioural reasons will not receive a refund/credit

Debit refunds will be issued by cheque and may take a few weeks to process. You will be notified by email or by phone when your cheque is available for pick up at Membership Services, please remember to provide a Photo ID upon pick-up.

The 3-strike rule for behavioural incidents:

- Strike 1 & 2: A call will be placed to the phone numbers on file by the Camp Counsellors, Site Lead or Supervisor & Site Lead/Supervisor or Camp Counsellor will speak to the authorized pick-up about the issue.
- Strike 3: The Site Lead or Supervisor will call the phone numbers on file and the child must be picked up that day and will not be allowed to return.
- Behavioural incidents will also be based on severity. If the issue results in any safety concerns for themselves, other children or the YMCA staff, the child will not be able to return.

- I will accept all campers and allow each camper equal opportunities and involvement;
- I will respect myself, others and our environment
- I will be responsible for my own actions, attitudes and behaviours.

Monday to Friday from 9 am - 4:30 pm
Drop off from 8:30 am - 9 am
Pick up from 4:30 pm - 5 pm
Camp does not run on stat holidays
(July 3 & August 7 stat holidays)

Behaviour Guidelines

1. Staff directs the child to more appropriate behaviour
2. The child is reminded of the behaviour guidelines and rules through a discussion
3. Staff notifies the Site Lead and/or Supervisor and writes an incident report
4. Staff notifies the parents/guardians by calling the phone numbers on the child's file and describes the incident
5. A staff member will then discuss the incident and possible solutions that best suit the needs of everyone upon pick-up with the authorized pick-up person.
6. If the problem persists to 3 incidents, the Supervisor will call the numbers on file and the child must be picked up immediately and will not be allowed to return. (please see Refund/Cancellation Policy)
 - a. If a child's behaviour at any time threatens the immediate health and safety of anyone, the parent/guardian is notified and instructed to pick up the child immediately and they will not receive a refund/credit. The Sault Ste. Marie YMCA reserves the right to suspend the child from the program.

Don't forget to pack

- Reusable water bottle
- A hat, sunscreen, change of clothes and running shoes
- Weather-appropriate clothing
- Nutritious peanut/nut free lunch

Sunscreen policy

Please note that sunscreen is not supplied to campers by the YMCA. It is the responsibility of the parent to ensure that campers bring their own sunscreen to camp and that the parent/child apply it once before coming to camp in the morning. Staff will assist campers in re-applying as needed throughout the day.
