We are currently looking for a Day Camp Counsellor to join our team of committed professionals. This full-time summer contract position within the Sault Ste. Marie YMCA.

Under the leadership of the Supervisor of Child, Youth and Family and the Site Lead, the Day Camp Counsellor is responsible for program planning and delivery to ensure participant satisfaction. The ideal candidate for this position is dynamic, able to work as part of a progressive team, enjoy working with children and can manage multiple tasks. Day Camp Counsellors should be energetic, self-motivated, and have the ability to work on their own.

Positions are available at two sites, Camp McNabb, and Sault College Waterfront. Available camps can include Dance/Gymnastics, Kid's Club, Sports & Games/Swim, Creative Discovery, and Sault College Waterfront Activity Centre*. MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES

- Plan and deliver daily programs: group games, crafts, swimming, outside time, etc.
- Supervise, engage and participate with the program participants in group activities
- Apply behaviour management training techniques with the program participants
- Communicate with all staff, Site Leads and Supervisors/Managers
- Ensure the safety of all participants, property, staff and volunteers by established practices and procedures
- Maintain the inventory of required supplies and request more when needed
- Welcome all children to programs
- Professionally always represent the YMCA
- Communication with parents daily
- Tracking daily attendance
- Build relationships with members and guests, and promote the YMCA as a charitable organization
